Your pet means the world to you and you want to provide the best love and care for them their whole life. This also means making plans for them in the event they outlive you.

Naturally you want the best for your loving companion, which is why we recommend that carefully considered arrangements need to be made for a friend or family to assume ownership and care after the death of their owner.

However, as this is not always possible, RSPCA Llys Nini offers an alternative option within the South Wales area to provide the happy future your pet deserves when you're no longer around.

We will take care of them and do all we can to find them someone special to look after them with a new happy forever home.

If you would like RSPCA Llys Nini to look after your pet for when the time comes to find a new loving forever home, please write to us using the contact form overleaf.

We will confirm in writing that we will accept your pet should anything happen to you. You will need to keep this confirmation safe with your Will and tell friends and family about your wishes.

All we ask in return is for you to leave a minimum of at least £100 to RSPCA Llys Nini to cover our expenses.

RSPCA Llys Nini has limited space so we may not be able to take in your pet straight away. If that is the case, we will put it into a private boarding establishment such as a local kennel or cattery until we do have room where we will then find it a new forever home.

It's all straightforward and you can then enjoy the rest of your life with your pet, safe in the knowledge they will be lovingly cared for when you're gone.



Why do RSPCA Llys Nini ask for a donation in your will to rehome your bereaved pet?

RSPCA Llys Nini is a small independently registered charity affiliated with the National RSPCA for England and Wales but we do not directly receive any funding from them.

All our running costs are funded by local donations and monies generated from the sale of donated items that are sold in our local charity shops throughout the South Wales area.

We ask people to leave us at least £100 in their will to help cover some of the costs of looking after your pet whilst in our care.

What you need to state in your Will

"I give RSPCA Llys Nini Cardiff to Swansea, registered charity number 224337 the sum of £x or the whole (or a share) of my residual estate."

It is a good idea to let your family, friends and the Executor of your Will know that you have registered your pet(s) with RSPCA Llys Nini and what they need to do and how to get in touch with us to let us know your pet needs to be rehomed. We'll then begin making the necessary arrangements to start caring for your pet.

Once your pet has been collected, we'll do all we can to make sure your pet is happy and healthy - including all necessary vaccinations and health checks - before starting the search for a new home. Any potential new owners will be thoroughly assessed and interviewed to check they can provide a loving home.

Finally, your pet will be ready to get happily settled into the next stage of their life with a caring new owner.
